

I watched the rock musical "Todd" and the movie "Sweeney Todd, the demon hairdresser from Fleet Street." I want to compare my impressions of the musical and the movie. I was at times more pleasant and more interesting to watch a musical than a movie. Because the musical is a "live" performance, live music is right from the stage! In the film there are no beautiful dances, feelings, emotions, games of actors and, of course, music. Let the musical recorded on camera, but the game of musicians and actors can not be compared with the actors in the film! I will sum up a little. None of the works I really liked. But in comparison, of course, theatrical production is much better than the film. I am for live music, interesting numbers, dances and special effects!
