

Today I would like to talk about what can be used on the flag to indicate the country. This question is quite extensive and multifaceted, as for different countries and peoples their own symbols and meanings of different colors and objects. For example, in one country - a bull, maybe it means strength and greatness, and in another anger and not inclination. In the same way also works with flowers.

I think that for a designation of the country, it is better to use a certain set of colours which will designate a condition of the country in what position it is in hands of invaders or in a free democratic society.
