Today, purple can only be seen on the flag of the Commonwealth of Dominica. He adorns the chest of the parrot sisserou is the symbol of this island nation. Another rare color that is present in only one state flag — the aquamarine. It stands for water on the flag of the Bahamas. The yellow stripe is the shore, and the black triangle symbolizes the unity and determination of the Bahamians. Now in the world there are no monochrome flags, but they were.

From 1815 to 1830, France had a monochrome white flag.

From 1880 to 1901, the flag of Afghanistan was a plain black canvas.

From 1977 to 2011, the flag of Libya was the only flag in the world in the form of a green rectangle.

As for me, I like all their meanings, but unfortunately, using them is all bad. Therefore, only two or three colors should be chosen as a symbol of the country's motto.

You can use symbols or images of something meaningful to your country as it is.
